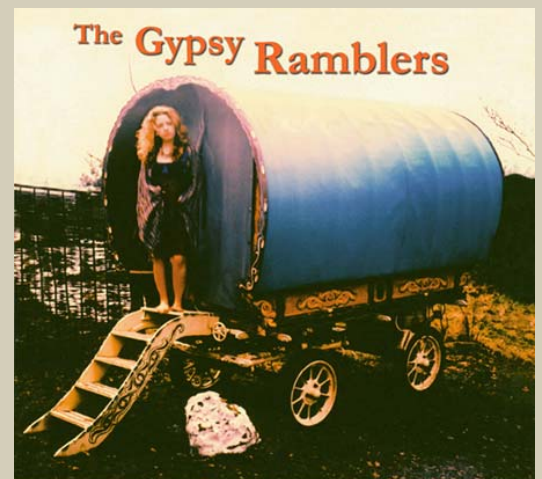


ON STAGE
